The Ministry of Mines and Minerals Development hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced individual consultants and consulting firms to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) for the undertaking of an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and preparation of the Environmental Project Brief (EPB) for the proposed sites for the construction of Mineral Processing Hubs.

The objective of this assignment is to assess the potential environmental and social impacts associated with the proposed developments and to ensure compliance with applicable environmental regulations and standards. The assignment will be carried out in Mufumbwe District of North Western Province, Lusangazi and Vubwi Districts of Eastern Province, and Chisamba District of Central Province.

The Ministry now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in undertaking the assignment. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to undertake the assignment. The shortlisting criteria required to demonstrate the Qualification and Experience of Consulting Firms are:

1. Certificate of Registration from the Patents and Companies Registration Agency (PACRA).
2. Valid Social Security Compliance Certificate.
3. Valid Tax Clearance Certificate issued by the Zambia Revenue Authority (ZRA).
4. Proof of Citizen or Local Ownership of the company.
5. Proof of Relevant Skills, including Curriculum Vitae (CVs) of key personnel. The team leader must possess at least a **Degree in Environmental Science/Engineering** or equivalent.
6. Demonstrated Technical Expertise, with evidence of successfully completed similar assignment(s) in the mining sector within the past one (1) year.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) Method based on procurement regulations and will be further set out in the Request for Proposals.
