The Government of the Republic of Zambia (GRZ) has received financing from the World Bank's International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Zambia Health Emergency Preparedness, Response and Resilience Project Using the Multiphase Programmatic Approach, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the credit toward the Procurement of Nineteen (19) Fully Equipped Brand New 4x4 Neonatal Ambulances. "For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit."
2. The Ministry of Health now invites Bids from eligible Bidders for the Supply and Delivery of Nineteen (19) Fully Equipped Brand New 4x4 Neonatal Ambulances. to be delivered in Lusaka at the Ministry of Health Headquarters with a **maximum delivery period of 6-10 Weeks. (On Shipment referred to as delivery)**
3. Bidding will be conducted through the **OPEN INTERNATIONAL BIDDING** using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-" September, 2023) ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the applicable World Banks Procurement Regulations for Investment Project Financing IPF November 2020 (4th edition).

3. Bidding will be conducted through the **OPEN INTERNATIONAL BIDDING** using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-" *September, 2023*) ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the applicable World Banks Procurement Regulations for Investment Project Financing IPF November 2020 (4th edition).

6. Bids will be submitted physically or through DHL for International Bidders only to the Ministry of Health Headquarters on **Wednesday 9th September 2026, 10:00 hour's Zambian local time**. Late Bids will be rejected. Bidders must submit 1 Original and 2 copies of bids.
7. The inner and outer envelopes shall:
 - (a) bear the name and address of the Bidder;
 - (b) be addressed to the Employer as provided in the BDS
 - (c) bear the specific identification of this bidding process indicated in accordance with ITB
8. If all envelopes are not sealed and marked as required, the Employer will assume no responsibility for the misplacement.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration with a suspension period of 3 years or 36 Months as per sample attached in the Solicitation Document.
9. "Attention is drawn to the World Bank's Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document."
