The Government of the Republic of Zambia through the Ministry of Health has received financing from the World Bank's International Development Association (IDA) for the Africa Centers for Disease Control Regional Investment Project implemented by the Zambia National Public Health Institute (ZNPHI). The ZNPHI would like to apply part of the proceeds of the credit to procure Consultancy Services for Evaluation of Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR) in Zambia (2021-2024) ("the Services"). The evaluation aims to provide insights into the strengths, weaknesses, and areas for improvement within the IDSR framework. The duration for the consultancy service is 4 months.

The ZNPHI now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services by submitting Expressions of Interest (EOI). Interested Consultants should submit EOI complete with information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the required Services (historical information and support documents such as brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, general qualifications and number, names and positions of key staff only such as Directors and principles of the firm. Details of key staff that may potentially be proposed in future if the firm is short listed and invited to prepare and submit a proposal should not be submitted at this EOI and Short List

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The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” July 2016 revised September 2023 “Procurement Regulations”, setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications and experience. In doing so the Consultants should indicate clearly the type of association – that is if it is in the form of a joint venture and / or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultant’s qualifications-based selection (CQS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
