Government of the Republic Zambia through Ministry of Mines and Minerals Development enacted the Geological and Minerals Development Act, No. 2 of 2025, establishing the Artisanal and Scale Scale Mining Department and the ASM, and the Ministry of Mines and Mines Development (MMMD) is in the process of issuing guidelines that define governance, eligibility, allocation and mechanisms, and frameworks for the Fund.

The ASM subsector is a critical source of livelihoods and contributes meaningfully to Zambia's production of gold, copper, gemstones, and other minerals, especially in remote areas where alternative economic opportunities are limited. Despite its importance, ASM faces persistent constraints: limited access to affordable finance and appropriate technologies, weak environmental, social and governance (ESG) compliance, lack of geological information, low financial literacy and bookkeeping capacity, limited market linkages, and low levels of formalization.

The Ministry now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The shortlisting criteria required to demonstrate the Qualification and Experience of Consulting Firms are:

1. Registered certificate with PACRA
2. Valid ZRA tax clearance certificate.
3. Proof of having done similar services in the last 5 years.
4. Proof of citizen owned entity
5. Chief Executive Officer with a degree in computer science or related program.
6. Technical lead with a degree in computer science or related program.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) Method based on procurement regulations and will be further set out in the Request for Proposals.

Expression of interest must be delivered in written form to the address below (in person) not later than 20th March, 2026.
