1. The Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC or “the Commission”) has provided funds in the budget for the year 2026 for the procurement of twenty-five (25No.) various laptops for the Commission.

Bidding will be conducted through open national bidding (ONB) procedures specified in the Public Procurement Act No. 8 of 2020 as amended by Public Procurement Act No. 17 of 2023 and the Public Procurement Regulations of 2022 and is restricted to **eligible citizen and local bidders**. The terms citizen and local bidder are defined in the Public Procurement Act No. 8 of 2020 as amended by Public Procurement Act No. 17 of 2023.

4. Interested Bidders are required to pay a non- refundable fee of Zambian Kwacha five hundred (K500.00) or its equivalent in any freely convertible currency through the online payment system provided for on the e-GP platform.
5. The bids should be submitted through the ZPPA e-GP platform via <https://eprocure.zppa.org.zm>; on or before **Friday, 15th May 2026 at 10:00 hours** local time. Hard copies and bids submitted outside the e-GP platform shall not be accepted. The bids will be opened online thirty (30) minutes after tender closing time at 10:30 hours.
