REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR DESIGN OF NATIONAL SPORT APPAREL AND ACCESSORIES

BACKGROUND:

The National Sports Council of Zambia (NSCZ) is a statutory body established under an Act of Parliament Chapter 142 of the Laws of Zambia to coordinate, promote and develop sport in Zambia. The Council has 15 main functions and operates through its National Sports Associations (NSA) whose mandate is to coordinate sport development programmes across the country.

NSCZ intends to engage consulting firms to design customizable national sports apparel. In accordance with Sections 9 (1) (l), NSCZ has a mandate to control the Award of National Colours to be used by individuals or groups participating in national sports assignments at national, regional, continental and global level. Currently, Zambia has no national colours or uniforms thereby depriving participants and citizens of a national identity in sport.

The consulting services ("the Services") include providing designs for various types of apparel in accordance with national colours that can be used by athletes and non-athletes participating in different forms of sport, recreation and similar activities. The apparel and accessories should include track suits, puffer jackets, jerseys, round necks, golf shirts, costumes, caps, backpacks, travel bags, vests, shorts, socks, sneakers, head bands, wrist bands, scarfs and water bottles.

The detailed Terms of Reference (TOR) for the assignment have been attached herewith.

NSCZ now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services by submitting EOI. Interested Consultants should submit EOI complete with information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the required Services (historical information and support documents such as brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, general qualifications and number, names and positions of key staff). Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications and experience. In doing so, the Consultants should indicate clearly the type of association - that is, if the association is in the form of a joint venture (JV) and / or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a JV, all the partners in the joint venture will be required to submit a JV agreement and the firms forming the JV shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
